fishing with a conscience

In Missouri we are fortunate enough to get to fish 12 months of the year. In order to do this, you need to have the right gear. Loon's helps me make sure my gear is ready, and that I stay on the water. From November through February, I don't hit the stream without lubing my reels with Reel Lube, and then my vest always has at least one container of Stanley's Ice Off. The fish in the photo was taken on a weekend when the high temperatures didn't get above 30 degrees (and that is a warm day for winter trout fishing in the Ozarks). The air temperature may be cold, but that doesn't stop the fish from rising, and when they do you can bet Aquel is on my fly.

Some people think I am crazy for chasing trout during the winter, maybe I should just tell them I am a Loonatic.
